Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

SAR Digital Limited is committed to achieving Net Zero Carbon emissions by 2050 at corporate level. This commitment supports the UK Government's net zero strategy and reflects our intention to embed carbon reduction as standard business practice rather than a bolt-on activity. This strategy sets out how emissions will be measured, reduced, and managed over time, with a clear preference for avoidance and reduction before any use of carbon offsetting. We will prioritise emissions reduction first, with offsetting used only for residual emissions where elimination is not currently feasible.

Net zero delivery will be embedded into operational decision-making and procurement practices to establish a long-term "green normal".

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline year: FY 2026–2027 (first full reporting year)

As a digital-led organisation, SAR Digital Limited's emissions are primarily associated with office energy use, business travel, IT equipment and limited supply chain activities.

Emissions sources included:

- **Scope 1:**
 - Company vehicle fuel use (where applicable)
- **Scope 2:**
 - Electricity consumption for offices and home-working environments
- **Scope 3 (initial categories):**
 - Business travel
 - Employee commuting (estimated)
 - IT equipment procurement
 - Key supplier services

Scope 3 coverage will expand as data quality improves.

Current Emissions Reduction Measures

SAR Digital Limited has already implemented the following measures:

- Digital-first operations reducing travel and paper usage
- Remote and hybrid working to minimise commuting emissions
- Use of cloud-based systems to reduce physical infrastructure
- Energy-efficient IT equipment procurement where replacements are required

Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following actions will be delivered over the contract period and beyond:

Short Term (2026–2030)

- Publish and maintain annual carbon reporting
- Reduce business travel through virtual-first engagement
- Transition to lower-emission vehicles where company transport is required
- Improve energy efficiency of office and home-working setups
- Introduce carbon awareness into supplier selection

Medium Term (2030–2040)

- Demonstrate measurable year-on-year emissions reductions
- Increase Scope 3 reporting coverage and accuracy
- Work with suppliers to encourage carbon reduction practices
- Review feasibility of renewable energy procurement

Long Term (2040–2050)

- Address residual emissions through verified offsetting only where necessary
- Achieve Net Zero Carbon status by 2050

Governance and Monitoring

- Responsibility for carbon reduction sits at senior management level
- Emissions will be reviewed annually against the baseline
- Carbon performance will inform operational and procurement decisions
- The Carbon Reduction Plan will be reviewed and updated regularly
